## What is GDPR

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is new legislation that will replace the Data Protection Act 1998 (DPA). GDPR provides more rights to individuals concerning their personal data and places greater onus on companies to handle personal data securely and with integrity.

When will GDPR come into effect?

25th May 2018

What type of changes can I expect as a result of GDPR?

GDPR follows the same principles as the DPA but it strengthens the existing position to offer more protection to you. Changes include:

- Increased rights to access your data
- Increased rights to have your data erased
- Increased rights concerning giving consent on the use of your data and how it is processed
- Increased penalties on firms breaching the new regulations

How will GDPR impact you in your dealings with Hobson and Latham?

GDPR will result in some enhancements to the way Hobson and Latham manages your personal data.
